

**Pupil Premium Grant Plan  
2018-19**

Funding for this year is based on 16 pupils totalling £23,420.

**Rationale:** The main barriers to educational achievement faced by eligible pupils at Little Sutton Church of England School are social and emotional and historical gaps in learning. We aim to address these barriers by offering specific, targeted learning, nurturing and enrichment opportunities. Much of this work will focus on raising self-esteem and building confidence.

**Impact:** This will be measured against specific learning objectives for individual pupils with the aim of closing the attainment gap for disadvantaged pupils.
